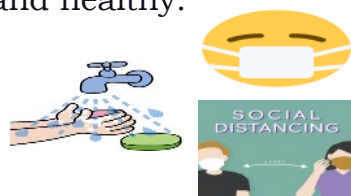

## Property Management Updates

- ⇒ There is a drop-box in front of the central office for payments and paperwork to be turned in.
- ⇒ The after-hours emergency new phone number for all sites is 931-575-1964.
- ⇒ Pest Control Week September 8-11, 2020 is for exterior treatment only.
- ⇒ Remember to pick up items and trash during the mowing season to not intrude on the lawn company from performing their job.
- ⇒ All work orders must come through the central office. Residents should not approach the maintenance staff for this request.
- ⇒ When parking on the street, please park with the flow of traffic.
- ⇒ Please update all new phone numbers and email addresses with the Central office.
- ⇒ Pet owners make sure to report pet information to the central office. Owners must walk pets on a leash while outside. The owner must clean all pet waste after walking.
- ⇒ There are no designated parking spaces for CHA residents; it's on a first-come basis.
- ⇒ Please ask guests to park on the street and not in resident parking stalls.
- ⇒ All vehicles parked in disabled parking must have a disabled sign visible cars will be tagged and towed.
- ⇒ Residents needing adjustments to the water heater, please contact maintenance for a work order for safety concern.
- ⇒ Rent is due on the 1st of every month. To avoid late payments rent must be received by the 5th of each month.
