- ⇒ Pest Control Week October 12-16, 2020 is for interior treatment only.
- ⇒ All work orders must come through the central office. Residents should not approach the maintenance staff for this request.
- ⇒ When parking on the street, please park with the flow of traffic.
- ⇒ There are no designated parking spaces for CHA residents; it's on a first-come basis.
- ⇒ Please ask guests to park on the street and not in resident parking stalls.
- ⇒ All vehicles parked in disabled parking must have a disabled sign visible cars will be tagged and towed.

- ⇒ Pet owners make sure to report pet information to the central office. Owners must walk pets on a leash while outside. The owner must clean all pet waste after walking. Sitting for pets friends or family is prohibited.
