Lease Volitions!!!

- Pet are not allowed without an pet agreement registered at the central office.
- Rent is due on the 1st of every month. To avoid late fees rent must be received by the 5th of each month.
- 3. Residents with unruly guest will be in lease volition. Unauthorized guest using a residents address alert the central office as an lease volition.
- All residents agreed upon move in to keep the unit clean and free of trash
- CHA's developments are NON-SMOKING there is no smoking on the properties.
- Pest Control Week is November 9-13, 2020 exterior units will be serviced this month.

Repairs & Parking

- The after-hours emergency new phone number for all sites is 931-575-1964.
- Residents need adjustments to the water heater, contact maintenance for a work order for resident's safety.
- All work orders are only called into the Central Of-
- If repairs are incomplete inform property management immediately.
- Vehicles are towed if parked in accessible parking spaces without being properly tagged. Vehicles blocking accessible and walkways are tagged and towed—Park vehicles in parking stalls ONLY.

Seasonal Updates & **Resident Meeting**

- 1. Test heaters and call in repairs to prepare for cold weather.
- 2. Open cabinets- leaving the cabinet doors under sinks open for 30 minutes to ventilate with warm air.
- Home Heat- During the winter months, maintain heat at a minimum of 68 degrees to prevent cold weather issues.
- 4. Frozen pipes- If water does not come on and there is water leaking inside or outside the unit, notify the office immediately
